



Systematic Land Registration Process Checklist

Systematic Land Registration is the methodical and orderly registration of parcels of land in a designated area.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any person who has acquired land by:

- ☐ Gift
- ☐ Purchase
- ☐ Inheritance
- ☐ Possession of the land for twelve (12) years or more

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- ☐ Tax Registration Number (TRN).
- ☐ Certificate of Payment of Property Taxes, if any.
- ☐ Valid National Photograph Identification
- ☐ Documentary proof of ownership-e.g. Receipts, Indentures, Agreements for Sale
- ☐ Two (2) neighbours who can confirm that the Applicant has been in open, undisturbed and undisputed possession of the land for twelve (12) years or more.
- ☐ A community member who can confirm that the Applicant has been in open, undisturbed and undisputed possession of the land for upwards of twelve (12) years.
